**About the donor**        The China Oxford Scholarship Fund was established in 1992 to provide financial assistance to Chinese postgraduate students who are permanent residents of mainland China and Hong Kong. Its founder is Sir David Akers-Jones, former Chief Secretary of Hong Kong. Since the Fund was created, 94 students have received awards and £329,000 has been disbursed. COSF's aim is to raise £25 million so that it will be able to provide fully endowed scholarships in perpetuity to more than 20 students every year.
